Churchyard Explorers

'Churchyard Explorers' is a project which has been devised to help children become part of our celebration of the International Year of Biodiversity. By following a trail of clues round the churchyard, they will look more closely at the wildlife to be found here, including trees, plants, birds, insects and animals and have the chance to get close enough to touch, feel, smell and listen as they explore. The trail is challenging enough to involve all school-age children but may be shortened and simplified for younger ones who will need some help from accompanying adults.

The Explorer's Map will be available from inside the church whenever the Adur Festival exhibition is open (see posters or look on www.stmarydehaura.org.uk) and we should be grateful for a contribution of 50p to help us with expenses. A badge and sticker will be awarded to every child who brings back their map and shows it to the 'welcomers' on duty inside the church door.

During this special year, we are hoping that everyone will be able to appreciate afresh the value of this amazing ancient green space in the centre of the busy town and be able to help us maintain its special role as a haven for wildlife and a source of refreshment for all visitors.
